

#### **Solution** Game Plot

- Private Newman is captured and questioned before he's knocked out with a rifle butt to the head by Pablo.
- Pablo is the leader of a terrorist cell and the main villain in this game. He kills all the squad apart from Newman and Downs.
- Private Downs rescues Newman and then they attempt to make an escape. the two are trapped in an ambush while trying to escape.
- The game then follows Chief from the previous game and Delta Squad on several mission: Oil rig in the Middle East, American embassy, The power plant...











### Game Play

- Typical warfare first person shooter similar to "Call of Duty"
- Some Modes: Single player and Multiplayer
- 50 The single-player campaign is made up of 12 missions
- Many environments:
  - Snowy mountains
  - Jungles
  - Buildings & villas
  - Slums















### Player's role

- The main role is to dismantle a terrorist organization lead by "Pablo"
- The player is thus sent on various missions:
  - Protect army convoy from terrorist attacks
  - Free hostages captured by terrorist in an American embassy
  - Capture different terrorist members to get Intel about their leader
  - Capture terrorist leader Pablo











### Multiplayer

- 50 Three different multiplayer options:
  - Online
  - Local Wi-Fi
  - Local Bluetooth
- Multiplayer modes include:
  - Capture the Flag
  - Death match
  - Team death match
  - defuse a bomb while the other team protects it.











### Multiplayer (cont.)

- Milling enemies and securing objectives earns experience points which allow players to level up through ranks on a global leaderboard
- Dp to 72 ranks each one unlocking new weaponry and earning various perks.
- Players from around the globe have privately set up clans and teams for members to train their skills and compete against other clans in organized matches







### Sound, Music and Artwork

- 50 3D is great with some cut scenes
- Variety of enemies with different spoken languages
- Music is immersive and dialogues are interesting
- Meapons sounds are unique and realistic











### Sound, Music and Artwork (cont.)

- Faces no longer look like textures stretched around a football, but like an actual person.
- Characters even have individual fingers!
- The environments are bright and colorful, and Gameloft uses some cool camera effects such as motion blurring and zoom-to-kill tracking for impressive headshots.











#### User Interface

- A virtual control stick is used for movement, while aiming is done by swiping on the screen. The controls can be customized in the pause menu.
- Quick time events have been added, where the player has to fight off knife wielding enemies or dodge a charging helicopter.
- Players can also crouch, throw a grenade, scope, reload, change weapon and shoot using buttons on the touch screen.
- 50 The game has gyroscopic control on the iPhone 4 and fourth generation iPod Touch.

### Single player mode

- Many environment to play in
- Great story line and 3D graphics
- QuickTime events, exploding walls, and unique enemies makes it immersive
- Smart Al for enemies
- Many weapons (up to 15)
- Challenging but with many assistance: aim assist, auto grenade, auto healing, objective arrow, hints

### Multiplayer player mode

- Fast and Easy to setup
- Variety of modes with up to 10 players (better from the previous release of 4)
- Up to 5 maps to chose from
- Persistent character
- earns experience points, allowing players to level up through 72 ranks
- rise up on the global leaderboard, and unlock new weaponry and perks





# Game Review



#### Bad

### Single player mode

- Too many controls on the screen
- Some graphics glitch if played for a long time
- No cover mechanics to quickly duck behind walls and barricades
- No buttons to run
- Controls takes some time to get used to
- Controls not as responsive
- Game play becomes repetitive in the long run

### Multiplayer player mode

- The character-tweaking mechanic is too simple
- There's no option to choose game rooms based on player skills
